Jeji Oreum

A place to experience the forest of life

The finishing point of Jeju Olle Trail Route 13, one of the most accessible routes in the Olle Trail, Jeji Oreum is renowned for its beautiful forests, which have won the "Forest of Life Award" in 2005 and the "8 Beautiful Forests of Korea Grand Award (Life Award)" in 2007. Jeji Oreum was originally known as "Dakmou Oreum," which came from the old name of Jeji, "Dakmou (Dakmo)"; a brisk walk of 45 min takes one to the peak, with a breathtaking view of the Sanbang Mountain, Songak Mountain, Geumak Oreum, and the Byangdo and Gapado Islands of the Pacific Ocean.

A song of peace on a treasure island

Located at the site of the imperialist violence of the Forced Occupation Period, the Jeju Peace Museum offers a valuable insight into the nature of war and peace through the fortifications and artillery sites along the coast.

Sanyang Gotjawal stands out among all Gotjawals because of its rolling rock formations and lava formations. The blackened ground suggests that charcoal was once made there for a living, while marshes, such as "Jorokmu" and "Jeoekkwimot," serve as sources of life in the Gotjawal. Feel your weariness being relieved just by being in the forest, particularly in the stillness of Sanyang Gotjawal and in proximity to nature. It is a hidden gem waiting to be discovered, just like the coastal and rural villages of Jeju.

A Tourist Shuttle Bus service provides this easy, quick, and affordable access to major tourist destinations and Oreum in the Jungsangan region, centered around Guju-eup, Daechon-dong, and Andeok-myeon, Donggwang-ri.

There are two circulation lines with 16 buses offering access to major tourist destinations in the Jungsangan region and Oreum, unlike the City Tour Bus of Jeju City. Tour guides with domestic tour guide qualifications serve on board every Tourist Shuttle Bus, offering information on and descriptions of each tourist destination, local culture, and restaurants to first-timers and expert tourists alike.

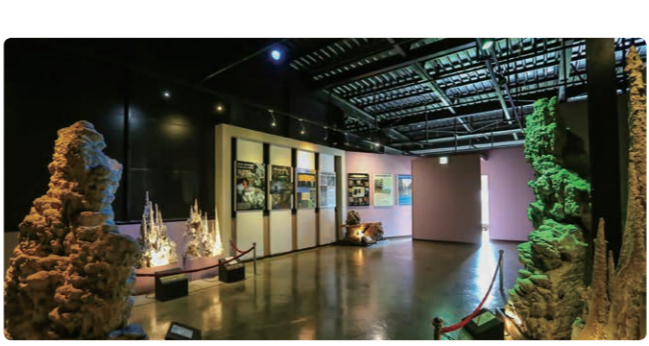

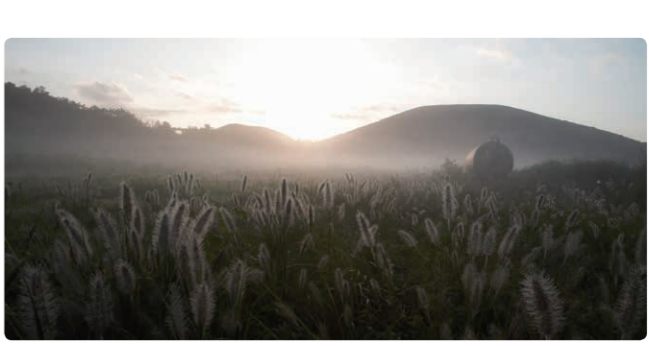

Hanul Land
One of Korea's largest mineral and fossil museums. Following the tradition of "Samdado," an island with plenty of wind, women, and stone, Hanul Land offers two theme museums of minerals/fossils and kites, as well as pension, resort, and restaurant facilities. Visitors can opt for learning programs on fossils and minerals, or try their hands at making their own kites to fly over the museum.

Jeju Rail Bike
A new paradigm for a family-friendly theme park. Set against the massive Yongnuni Orem in the field of Jongdal-ri, Gjuwaeup, Jeju Rail Bike is home to 90 pedal-powered rail bikes that circulate 4 km-long tracks. It takes a total of 40 min to completely circulate the rail, and windscreens allow visitors to enjoy the sight even during the rainy or winter season.

Geoseunsemi Orem
A Volcanic cone in defiance of natural laws. Geoseunsemi Orem is easily accessible from the farm opposite of Songdang Farm. The name "Geoseunsemi" comes from a fountain at the western slope of the Orem. The slopes of the Orem are dominated by cedar forests. As the stream (Yongcheon) from the fountain flows toward the Halla Mountain, as opposed to the sea, the fountain is called Geoseunsemi (fountain in a reverse direction). It is one of the handful of such "reverse" fountains among the parasitic cones of the island.

How to Get to the 810 Tourist Shuttle Bus

From the Airport

- Daecheon Transit Center: Take bus 110-1, 110-2, 120-1, 120-2 from the airport.

From the Harbor

- Daecheon Transit Center: Take bus 465-1, 465-2 from the pier to the terminal, and transfer to bus 110-1, 110-2, 120-1, 120-2, 210-1, 210-2, 220-1, 220-2.



Eodae Orem
A streamlined hill for a leisurely stroll. The name Eodae Orem already betrays the comfortable, streamlined nature of its ridge. Standing 210.5 m above sea level at the summit, it takes only 20 min to walk to the summit, making it suitable for a leisurely stroll for those new to the Orem climbing scene. To the southwest lies the Juche Orem, while the northeastern part is home to the Deokcheon-ri Hadong (Ildeokcheon and Hadeokcheon) area. The natural cave, "Daerim Cave," formerly of "Keungotgeomeol"; lies to the west of Eodae Orem.



Yongnuni Orem
A complex volcanic formation with two parasitic cones. Yongnuni Orem is unique in its complex construction of three peaks, centered around the Jeongsangbong of the northeast, with an oval-shaped crater with two parasitic cones inside. The Orem itself takes after the usual picture of Jeju Orem, covered in grass and boasting of a beautiful scenery. The name of the Orem comes from the observation that the Orem formation resembles a dragon lying down, or the crater of the hill resembling a place where the dragon had settled in the past.



Andol Orem
Savor the comfort of Jeju on the summit. Andol Orem stands next to the Batdol Orem, which is located at the northeastern side of the Orem. The names of the two Orem come from the stone fence that was located between the Orem, with one called "Andol" for being within the fence, and the other called "Batdol" for being outside the fence. The northeastern side of Andol Orem features the "Dohoregimul" and "Oloregimul" fountains. The only natural forest in the Orem exists at the foot of the Oloregimul fountain, while the summit itself is dominated by a wide field of grass.

Jeju World Natural Heritage Center
Secrets of Jeju's formation revealed. The Jeju World Natural Heritage Center was built to commemorate the value of Jeju's nature, the only site in Korea to attain the three certifications of UNESCO (World Natural Heritage, Global Geopark, and Biosphere Reserve). The 4-D theater, which documents the creation of Jeju, exhibitions on the life of the Halla Mountain, and lava tubes, makes this destination the most important one for lovers of nature in Jeju.

Geomun Orem
The best of UNESCO's Natural Heritage. Geomun Orem houses the largest erosion gully formed by volcanic activities in Jeju, which stretches for 4 km in a U shape. It is also known as Geomulchang (Geomelchang) and "Geomun Orem," or "black Orem"; the etymological roots of the character "Geom" is thought to be stemming from the character "Gam" or "Geom" of the Gojoseon Period. Hence, Geomun Orem is interpreted as a "holy mountain".

Abu Orem
Harmony of nature in a Volcanic cone. Abu Orem is rightly renowned for its view of Jeju's scenery from the gentle slopes of the hill. It is written as 亞父峯 (Abuak) and 阿父峯 (Abuak) in Sino-Korean characters, while its position to the southern side of Songdang Village and Dang Orem also entitles it to the name of 前岳 (Jeonak). Abu Orem is the one and only Orem with a cedar forest in the crater itself, making it easier for visitors to find the forest. It is also known for being the filming site of The Uprising and Love Wind, Love Song.



Fairy and the Woodcutter
A call back to old memories. Fairy and the Woodcutter brings back the memories of the 50s to the 80s, with authentic paraphernalia and an even more realistic atmosphere. Visitors can enjoy school uniform rentals (free), go-go, a horror house, traditional plays, and other things that harken back the period of the popular tvn drama series, Reply.

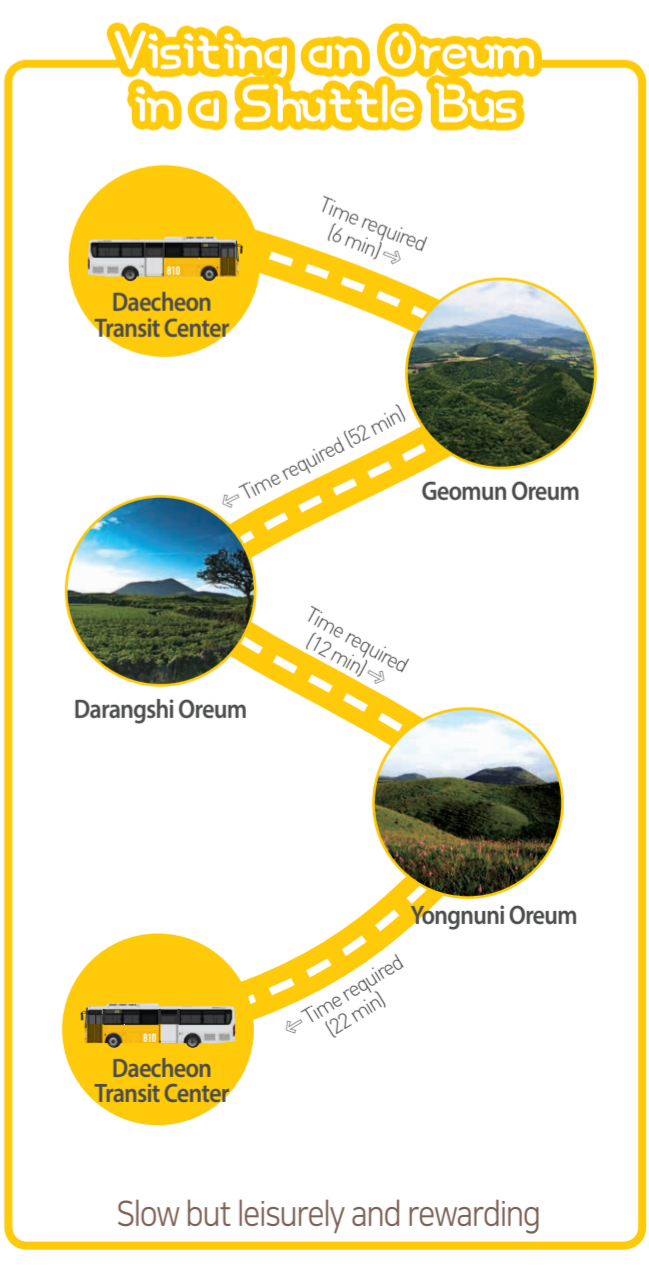
Camellia Hill Wetlands Center

A nutmeg forest of a thousand years. Nearly 2,800 Bijar (nutmeg) trees, each aged between 500 and 800 years, are found in one of the largest single-species forests in the world. Designated as the 374th Natural Monument of Korea, Bijarim offers an accessible route into the heart of nature. The edge of the forest is dotted with nutmeg trees that are said to be of a thousand years.

Darangshi Orem
A tragic chapter in Jeju's history. The Queen Orem of Gjuwaeup with a large cedar forest, Darangshi Orem is home to a darker secret of the Darangshi Cave, where the remains of the 11 victims of the April 3rd Massacre were found. The top of the Orem features a deep and large conical crater. The oval-shaped crater is nearly 1,500 m large in terms of outer circumference, with the northern side being comparatively flat while the southern side being as deep as Baekrodam crater on Hallasan Mountain.
